## WHAT DOES CLEVELAND CLIFFS DO IF A LEAK OCCURS?

To prepare for the event of a leak, pipeline companies regularly communicate, plan and train with local emergency responders. Upon the notification of an incident or leak the pipeline company will immediately dispatch trained personnel to assist emergency responders.

Pipeline operators and emergency responders are trained to protect life, property and facilities in the case of an emergency.

Pipeline operators will also take steps to minimize the amount of product that leaks out and to isolate the pipeline emergency.

# MAINTAINING SAFETY AND INTEGRITY OF PIPELINES

Cleveland Cliffs invests significant time and capital maintaining the quality and integrity of their pipeline systems. The Cleveland Cliffs natural gas pipeline is



monitored 24 hours a day. Cleveland Cliffs utilizes on-ground observers to identify potential dangers. Control center personnel continually monitor the pipeline system and assess changes in pressure and flow. They notify field personnel if there is a possibility of a leak

Gas transmission pipeline operators have developed supplemental hazard and assessment programs known as Integrity Management Programs (IMPs). Specific information about Cleveland Cliffs' program contact us directly.


